Entries:

- Entries **must be received by Wednesday** prior to the show date or they will be subject to the post entry fee indicated on the entry form.
- Age of Horse and Rider will be as of January 1 of the current year.
- No HORSE & RIDER combination may CROSS ENTER seat disciplines.
- Registration papers must be presented in order to enter a Registered Pleasure Horse class.
- **VSE** (Very Small Equine) and Miniature Horses must be no more than 40" tall. Registration papers for VSE/Miniature Horses are not required.
- VSE / Minis are limited to classes: 1, 3, 4, 7, 12, 13, 18, 25, 26, 46, 47
- Proof of **NEGATIVE COGGINS** must be presented. For horses stabled in MA, a negative Coggins report within one year; for horses stabled outside MA, a negative Coggins report within 6 months is required.
- To be eligible for **Year End RRDC Championships**, the Exhibitor must be a current year PAID member PRIOR to showing. Points earned by the Exhibitor will be accumulated for each Show attended.
- **Regular Classes are \$15 each**
- **Championship Classes are \$20 each**

Show Rules & Regulations

1. The RRDC Horse Show Committee reserves the right to Add, Combine, Cancel, Split, or Reorder classes as necessary.
2. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to be registered and to enter the show ring(s) only for classes that are suitable for their ability, age, equine, and discipline. The exhibitor will incur an entry fee for participating in any class- suitable or not.
3. Scratches from classes must be made at least 3 classes in advance. NO REFUNDS on classes that are held, unless due to an injury to horse or rider.
4. Appropriate riding attire is required for each class. Shoes with a heel are required in all classes. Sneakers are not permitted in any class.
5. The In-Gate will close **TWO MINUTES** after the class has been announced and called to the ring. If you require a "HOLD" on a class for a tack change, please make that known to the Show Secretary at least 2 classes prior to the class you wish to hold; otherwise your "HOLD" will not be honored.
6. Horses or ponies with a tendency to kick **MUST** wear a **RED** ribbon on their tail as a caution to other riders.
7. The decisions of the Judges in the Main Show Ring and Trail Ring are Final.
8. Exhibitors must receive permission from the Show Secretary before speaking to any Judge. An exhibitor may not speak with the Judge until after completion of that exhibitor's last class of the day.

Additional Information:

- Food Concession is available on the show grounds. Please support the vendor.
- Other Vendors, Bake Sales, Raffles, or Fund Raisers are not permitted at the show without permission of the RRDC Committee.
- **BRING WATER FOR YOUR HORSES.**
- Clean up all manure and hay around your trailer before leaving the show grounds. Bring your own trash home with you.
- **NO SMOKING** on the Show Grounds.
- **DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEASH.**
- Lunging is to be kept to a minimum.

VSE High Point Challenge Trophy **3, 4, 12, 13, 25, 47**

This perpetual trophy will be presented to the VSE with the most accumulated points for the year.

Points for RRDC Year End Awards will be accumulated as follows:

REGULAR CLASSES

- 1st = 8 points
- 2nd = 6 points
- 3rd = 5 points
- 4th = 4 points
- 5th = 3 points
- 6th = 2 points

CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

- 1st = 12 points
- 2nd = 10 points
- 3rd = 8 points
- 4th = 7 points
- 5th = 6 points
- 6th = 5 points

Class Descriptions

- 1. Open Colts and Fillies** - Open to Horses, Ponies, and VSE's 2yrs of age and under. A maximum of 2 handlers are allowed. Dams not allowed into the show ring with entry. To be shown in a suitable halter or bridle and required to move at a walk and trot/jog both ways of the ring. To be judged on quality, conformation, way of going and soundness.
- 2. Open Fitting & Showmanship** - Open to Horses and Ponies with one Exhibitor of any age. To be shown in a suitable halter or bridle on the line at a walk and trot/jog. To be judged 40% Condition, Grooming, and Fitness (Conformation not to count); 10% Appearance of Exhibitor and Cleanliness of tack; 50% Showmanship.
- 3. Open VSE Fitting & Showmanship** - Open to VSEs (40" and under) with one Exhibitor of any age. To be shown in a suitable halter or bridle on the line at a walk and trot/jog. To be judged 40% Condition, Grooming, and Fitness (Conformation not to count); 10% Appearance of Exhibitor and Cleanliness of Tack; 50% Showmanship.
- 4. Open VSE Halter** - Open to VSEs (40" and under). To be shown standing, then at a walk and trot on the line. Must be serviceably sound. Judged on conformation, quality, presence, way of going and type.
- 5. Open English In Hand** - Open to horses and ponies 3yrs of age and older. To be shown in hand standing, then at a walk and trot on the line. Must be serviceably sound. Judged on conformation, type, and performance.
Same handler ineligible for Class 6.
- 6. Open Halter Western** - Open to horses and ponies 3yrs of age and older. To be shown in hand standing, then at a walk and jog on the line. Must be serviceably sound. To be judged on type, conformation, quality and substance.
Same handler ineligible for Class 5.
- 7. Lead Line Equitation** - Open to Lead Line riders 8yrs of age and under. To be judged at the walk and trot/jog, with emphasis on Rider Participation. Leader MUST be 16yrs of age or older. Exhibitors in this class may only enter riding classes **18 & 46**.
- 8. Saddle Seat Equitation** - Open to Saddle Seat riders. To be judged at the walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Horses shall be shown in a full bridle and flat English-type saddle.
- 9. Western Equitation** - Open to Western riders. To be judged at the walk, jog, and lope both ways of the ring.
- 10. Hunt Seat Equitation JR-Exhibitor 13&under** - Open to Hunt Seat riders age 13yrs & under. To be judged at the walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring.
- 11. Hunt Seat Equitation JR-Exhibitor 14-17** - Open to Hunt Seat riders age 14-17 years old. To be judged at the walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring.
- 12. VSE Pleasure Driving** - Open to VSE (40" and under). To be shown both directions of the ring at the Walk, Pleasure Trot, and Working Trot. Horse must stand quietly and back readily. To be judged on the suitability of the horse to provide a pleasurable drive. Emphasis on attitude, manners, performance and quality. Individual performances may be requested. Driver may wear a safety helmet.
- 13. VSE Reinsmanship** - Open to VSE drivers. To be shown individually at a walk, slow trot, working trot and strong trot. Driver required to rein back. Judged 75% on handling of reins & whip, control, posture, and overall appearance of driver; 25% on condition of the harness, vehicle, and neatness of attire. Pattern will be posted. Driver may wear a safety helmet.

14. Saddle Seat Equitation Championship - Open to Saddle Seat riders who have shown in Class **8**. Same specifications as Class **8**. Individual performances may be requested.

15. Western Equitation Championship - Open to Western riders who have shown in Class **9**. Same specifications as Class **9**. Individual performances may be requested.

16. Hunt Seat Equitation Adult - Open to Hunt Seat riders 18yrs of age and older. To be judged at the walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring.

17. Adult Walk-Trot Equitation (all seats) - Open to riders 12yrs of age and older. To be judged at the walk and trot/jog both ways of the ring.

Riders in this class may not compete in any class requiring the canter or lope.

18. Lead Line Pleasure - Open to Lead Line riders 8yrs of age and under. To be shown at the walk and trot/jog. To be judged on manners, performance, substance, and suitability to the rider. Leader **MUST** be 16yrs of age or older. Exhibitors in this class may only enter riding classes **7 & 46**.

19. Walk-Trot Equitation 11 & Under (all seats) - Open to riders 11yrs of age and under. To be judged at the walk and trot/jog both ways of the ring.

Riders in this class may not compete in any class requiring the canter or lope.

*Entry form must indicate Seat Discipline. Class may be split.

20. Registered Pleasure Horse – Western - Open to Western riders. To be shown at a walk, jog and lope both ways of the ring. Emphasis on manners, performance and substance. To work on a reasonably loose rein without loss of contact. Shall stand quietly. May be asked to back.

21. Hunt Seat Equitation Championship - Open to Hunt Seat riders who have shown in Class **10, 11 or 16**. Same specifications as Classes **10, 11, 16**. Individual performances may be requested.

22. Novice JR-Exhibitor Equitation (all seats) - Open to riders 12yrs of age and under. To be judged at the walk, trot/jog, and canter/lope both ways of the ring.

Riders must be in their first calendar year of cantering or loping at any horse show. Riders in this class may only enter riding Classes **27, 32, 38, 44** and Fun classes.

23. Registered Pleasure Horse – English - Open to Hunt Seat and Saddle Seat riders. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Emphasis on manners, performance and substance. To work on a reasonably loose rein without loss of contact. Shall stand quietly. May be asked to back.

24. Walk-Trot Pleasure 11 & Under (all seats) - Open to riders 11yrs of age and under. To be shown at the walk and trot/jog both ways of the ring. To be judged on manners, performance, substance, and suitability to the rider.

Riders in this class may not compete in any class requiring the canter or lope.

*Entry form must indicate Seat Discipline. Class may be split.

**** 20 - 30-minute LUNCH ** VSE Driving - Cones Class to run right after the break ****

25. VSE Driving - Cones Course - Open to VSE (40" and under). A timed event where drivers navigate through the course of cones (gates) with a ball on top of each cone. Penalties are accumulated if cones are hit and a ball is dislodged. The fastest cleanest run wins the class. Canter is prohibited. Exhibitors must wear a safety helmet.

26. Open Costume - Open to Horses, Ponies, and VSE's. To be judged 75% on originality of costume and 25% on presentation. To be shown at the walk.

- 27. Ranch Horse Pleasure** - Open to Western riders of any age who are eligible to lope. To be shown at the walk, jog, and lope both directions; extended jog and extended lope in one direction. To be judged on manners, responsiveness and quality of movement while performing the required gaits.
- 28. Walk-Trot Equitation Championship - 11 & Under** (all seats) - Open to riders who have shown in Class **19**. Same specifications as Class **19**. May be asked to back.
- 29. Western Pleasure** - Open to Western riders. To be shown at the walk, jog, and lope both ways of the ring. Emphasis on manners, performance, and substance.
To work on a reasonably loose rein without loss of contact. May be asked to back.
- 30. English Pleasure** - Open to Saddle Seat riders. To be shown at the walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring, with emphasis on manners, performance and substance. May be asked to back.
- 31. Adult Walk-Trot Pleasure** (all seats) - Open to riders 12yrs through Adult. To be shown at the walk and trot/jog both ways of the ring. To be judged on manners, performance, and substance.
Riders in this class may not compete in any class requiring the canter or lope.
- 32. Novice JR-Exhibitor Pleasure** (all seats) - Open to riders 12yrs of age and under. To be shown at the walk, trot/jog, and canter/lope both ways of the ring.
Riders must be in their first calendar year of cantering or loping at any horse show. Emphasis on manners, performance, and substance. To work on a reasonably loose rein without loss of contact.
Riders in this class may only enter riding classes **22, 27, 38, 44,** and Fun classes.
- 33. Walk-Trot Pleasure Championship 11 & Under** (all seats) - Open to riders who have shown in Class **24**. Same specifications as Class **24**.
- 34. Hunter Pleasure JR-Exhibitor 13 & under** - Open to Hunt Seat riders 13yrs & under. To be shown at the walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring, with emphasis on manners, performance, and substance. To work on a reasonably loose rein without loss of contact. May be asked to back.
- 35. Hunter Pleasure JR-Exhibitor 14-17** - Open to Hunt Seat riders 14-17yrs old. To be shown at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring, with emphasis on manners, performance, and substance. To work on a reasonably loose rein without loss of contact. May be asked to back.
- 36. Hunter Pleasure Adult** - Open to Hunt Seat riders 18yrs and older. To be shown at the walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Emphasis shall be placed on manners, performance, and substance. Shall work on a reasonably loose rein without loss of contact. May be asked to back.
- 37. Adult Walk-Trot Championship** (all seats) - Open to riders who have shown in Class **17 and/or 31**. Same specifications as Class **31**.
- 38. Novice JR-Exhibitor Championship** (all seats) - Open to riders who have shown in Class **22 and/or 32**. Same specifications as Class **32**.
- 39. Western Pleasure Championship** - Open to Western riders who have shown in Class **29**. Same specifications as Class **29**.
- 40. English Pleasure Championship** - Open to Saddle Seat riders who have shown in Class **30**. Same specifications as Class **30**.
- 41. Hunter Pleasure Championship** - Open to Hunt Seat riders who have shown in Class **34, 35 or 36**. Same specifications as Classes **34, 35, 36**.

42. Grooms Class – A fun class - Walk and Trot / Jog only. Open to people who have helped out today! Anything can happen. Have fun!

**** TRAIL and VSE Obstacles in the Trail Ring ****

Course open from 10:00 am – 2:00 pm – First come, first served

VSE Course will be set up after all Trail Horse entries have completed

Trail Class and VSE Obstacles Specifications

To be judged on performance of the horse over obstacles, emphasis on manners, response to the exhibitor, and quality of movement.

A 60-second time limit allowed for each obstacle.

Courses will be posted near the Trail Ring Gate.

43. Trail Horse –Adult-Open to riders 18 yrs of age and older, *eligible to Canter or Lope*.

44. Trail Horse – JR-Exhibitor-Open to riders 17 yrs of age and under, *eligible to Canter or Lope*.

45. Trail Horse – Walk-Trot- Open to *Walk-Trot riders* of any age.

46. Trail Horse- Lead Line-Open to *Lead Line riders* 8 yrs of age and under.

Leader must be 16 yrs of age or older. Emphasis on Rider Participation.

47. VSE Obstacles - (in Hand) - Open to VSE's (40" and under) with one Exhibitor of any age.

**** FUN CLASSES to be offered in the Main Ring if enough interest and time ****

Musical Grain Bags – Open to all riders. Elimination game. Musical Chairs with Grain bags! When the music stops, dismount, run w/horse and step on a bag!

Mint Julip - Open to all riders. A fun class - Each rider is given a cup of water. Hold the cup of water while riding. After walking and trotting, the riders present their cups for measuring. The one with the most water remaining wins.

Egg & Spoon – Open to all riders. A fun class - Balance the egg in a spoon while riding. The last person who still has the egg in their spoon wins!
