Show Grounds located at the Essex County Greenbelt property (Ewell Estate) Haverhill St, Rte 133 Rowley

SHOW STARTS 9am. Passenger vehicles not allowed up with the HORSE TRAILER PARKING.

Entries **must be received by Wednesday** prior to the show date, or they will be subject to the post entry fee indicated on the entry form.

Age or Horse and Rider will be as of January 1 of the current year.

Proof of Negative Coggins must be presented. For horses stabled in MA a negative Coggins report within one year, for horses stabled outside MA a Negative Coggins report within 6 months is required.

SCRATCHES from classes must be made at least 3 classes in advance. NO REFUNDS on classes that are held, unless due to an injury to horse or rider.

Horses or ponies with a tendency to kick MUST wear a RED ribbon on their tail as a caution to other riders.

The decisions of the Judges in the Show Ring and Trail Ring are Final.

Exhibitors must receive permission from the Show Secretary before speaking to any Judge. An exhibitor may not speak with the Judge until after completion of that exhibitor's last class of the day.

Food Concession is available on the show grounds.

There is a water source on the grounds, we ask that you BRING WATER FOR YOUR HORSES.

Clean up all manure and hay around your trailer before leaving the show grounds. Bring your own trash home with you.

NO SMOKING on the Show Grounds DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEASH
